## Parent-Teacher Conferences

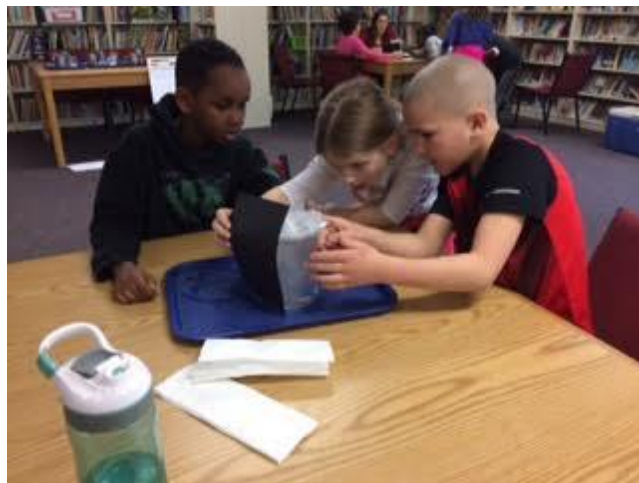
March 30-31
