### CHILD PICK-UP

The Afterschool program ends at 5:30pm each day. If you come during class time (roughly 3:50 – 5:15 each day) we request that you look at the sign-out sheet to find where your child is and meet them at that location. Please remember, **it is very important that you physically sign your child out** – it helps us to make sure everyone is accounted for! For the safety of all students and staff members, when ENTERING and leaving the building please use only the **main entrance doors**.

*You will be charged \$10 for every 5 minutes that you are late to pick up your child.*

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**EXTRA CLOTHES:** From time to time, accidents do happen – whether it’s a surprise mud puddle on the playground, a colorful paint spill, or other... messes. **Therefore, we recommend that all students, regardless of age, have an extra change of clothes.** A gallon-sized Ziploc bag, holding at least an extra pair of socks, pants, and underwear, fits nicely in the bottom of a backpack and can stay there until needed.



**COLD/MUDDY WEATHER:** Students at Afterschool will be going outside for free play as much as possible, even during the cold weather months. We will follow the school policy as to when it is too cold to go outside, but otherwise we will go out. **It is very important that all children have warm clothes** – hat, gloves/mittens, boots, winter jacket, snowpants, etc. Boots and snowpants are also a good idea during mud season as they help keep kids clean and dry.

# Kindergarten

Starting school is a big change and we want to make afterschool an easy transition. Kindergarteners do not have to sign up for classes for Session 1 and will get a chance to take classes starting in Session 2. All Kindergarteners will be enrolled in K Club, and a few 1st graders who sign up.

**K-1 Club:** K Club is a laid-back, quiet activity space centered around student choice. You will have the opportunity to color, play games, build with LEGOs, read, go outside or just hang out with your friends. The choice is yours and the possibilities are endless! **Teachers:** Ms. Amber & Ms. Katon

## Monday

**Comedy Club:** Join professional comedian, Mark Stein in this workshop, we will explore a wide range of theater arts, including improvisational comedy, and storytelling. The world of improv can be a hilarious place! **Teacher:** Ms. Tanya

**Things That Fly & Float:** Get hands-on experience with science and engineering in this class. Build cool things like hot air balloons, rockets, gliders, tin foil boats, and more. Then test them out in experiments and activities designed to bring out your inner engineer! **Teacher:** Ms. Olivia

**Magic the Gathering (Grades 2-5):** Back by popular demand! The Gathering is the first and most widely played roleplaying card game. Players take on the role of powerful mages who battle for glory, knowledge and conquest. Their tools include spells, creatures, and artifacts gathered from a vast Multiverse of unique fantasy worlds.
